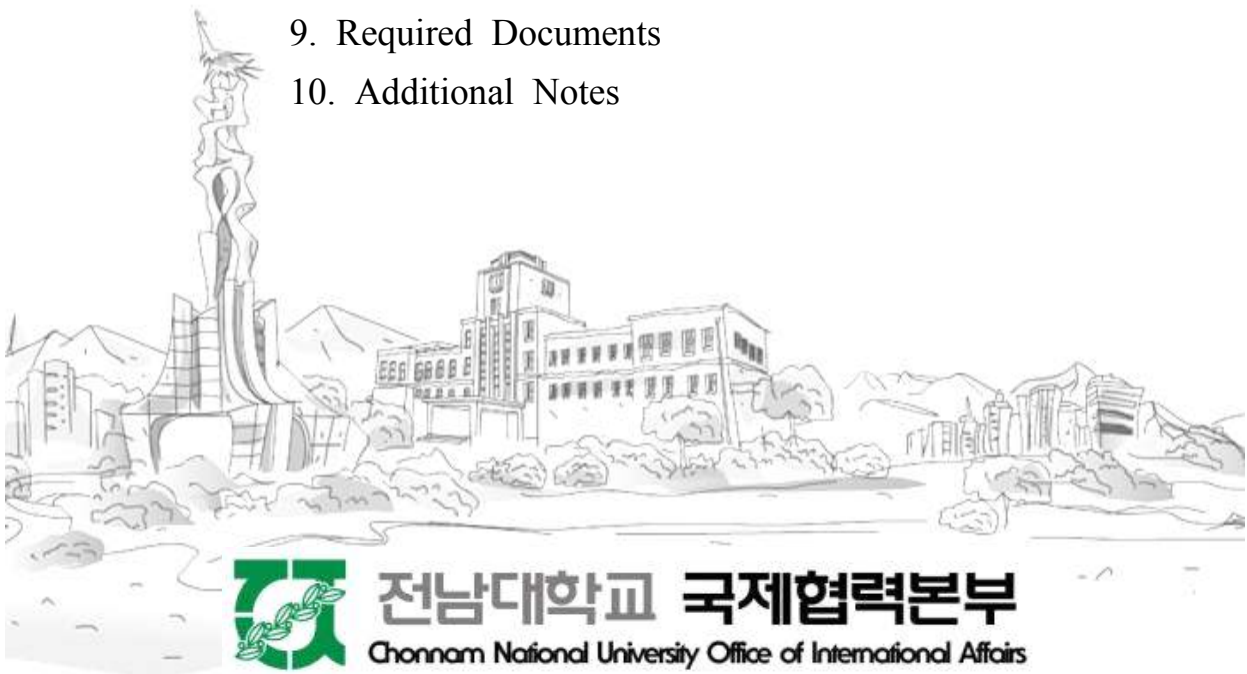

2. Eligibility

Status	Education Course	Nationality
Freshmen	Foreign students who completed or who are expected to complete secondary education	Both of the applicant's parents should hold a foreign passport. Applicants with dual citizenship (including Korean citizenship) are not eligible to apply
Transfer (Sophomore, Junior)	Foreign students who completed secondary education and are expected to complete 2 years at a 4-year university, or to graduate from a two or three year junior college.	

■ Language Requirements(Must meet one or more of the following requirements):

- **Gwangju Campus Applicants:** Standard Test of Proficiency in Korean level(TOPIK) 3 or CNU Korean language courses level 3

- **Yeosu Campus Applicants:** Standard Test of Proficiency in Korean level(TOPIK) 2, or CNU Korean language center 2

※TOPIK level 2 to 6 are considered equivalent with LEC Korean Language Class levels 2 to 6 respectively.

- TOEFL PBT 550, CBT 210, iBT 80 or IELTS 5.5, TOEIC 700 or TEPS 550

Citizens or nationals of English-speaking countries are exempt from the English language proficiency requirement (**USA, UK, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Ireland, South Africa**).

※ Academic Performance will be evaluated by each department and the process may include additional documents and interviews. Applicants who do not get a minimum of 60% of points at the department screening will not be accepted.

6. CNU Scholarships

A. Academic Performance Scholarships (Freshmen only)

- **Scholarship 1** : Tuition I, II and admission fee waiver for the first semester
- **Scholarship 2** : Tuition II waiver for the first semester
- **Scholarship 3** : Half of the tuition II waiver for the first semester
- **Scholarship 4** : Tuition I and admission fee waiver for the first semester

B. CNU Scholarship II

- **1 year Scholarship:** Tuition and admission fee waiver for 1 year (2 Semesters)

※ **Conditions of Keeping the Scholarship:** GPA 3.0 or above in the previous semester (For the first semester, GPA 2.5 or above), Scholarship may be canceled if student's status changes.(e.g. leave of absence, withdrawal)

- **First Semester Scholarship:** Tuition and admission fee waiver for the first semester
- **First semester Partial Scholarship:** First semester tuition waiver 1,000,000 KRW

※ Scholarship offers may change.

7. Application Fee: 60,000 won(KRW)

▣ Applicants who do not pay the application fee will not be eligible to apply

▣ **Application Fee Refund Policy**(In most cases, the application fee is non-refundable. However, exceptions may be made based on the following circumstances)

Reason for Refund	Refund Amount	Refund Method
◦ Over-payment of the application fee (will only refund the fee except the transferring fee & may not refund if the transferring fee exceeds the actual amount of the refund)	Overpaid amount	Will contact the applicant individually
◦ Failure to submit application due to reasons caused by the university	Full amount	
◦ Failure to complete application due to natural disaster	Full amount	
◦ Failure to complete application due to the applicant's hospitalization (from an illness or accident) or death. (must submit supporting documents)	Full amount	

※ We do not refund the application fee if you applied for the admission but the application was not admitted due to admission eligibility (e.g. missing or insufficient documentation etc.)

10. Additional Notes

- When filling out the online application, the applicant must fill out his full name as in his passport. After completing the online application it is not allowed to change a department.
- Course completed or expected to graduate applicants must submit an official verification of graduation or completion **within 15 days of admission** to the Office of International Affairs.
- After the acceptance of admission, even if the Statement of Financial Resource(Form 4) is already submitted, the current bank statement(**more than USD 18,000**) of financial guarantee is required to apply for a visa.
- Students who submitted forged documents may be disqualified.
- Applicants who provided incorrect contact information or failed to communicate may be disqualified.
- Submitted documents and application fees will neither be returned nor refunded.(Original certificate of graduation will be returned after the application process is completed.)**
- CNU will not reveal the evaluation records of each application process under any circumstances.
- Matters that are not included in this guide shall proceed according to the CNU's evaluation methods.
